### **VIRTUAL RENEWAL CLASSES FOSTER AND KINSHIP CARE EDUCATION**

Foster and Kinship Care Education (FKCE) classes provide quality education and support opportunities for caregivers of children and youth in out-of-home care enabling these providers to meet the educational, emotional, behavioral and developmental needs of the children in their care.

FKCE classes are open to all Resource Parents (foster parents, relative caregivers, non-relative family member) and anyone else who is interested in or who works with children care.

#### **Resource Parents Include:**

- People who care for non-relative children in out-of-home care. Also, known as **Foster Parents**.
- People who care for their relative children, such as grandparents, uncles/aunts, older siblings. Also known as **Relative Caregivers**
- People who may not be related, but care for children of close friends of the family. Also known as **Non-Relative Family Members**.

***Interested Parties*** may be teachers, day care providers, medical or emergency professionals, potential foster parents, child development majors, or anyone who is interested in foster children, children or care issues.

#### **All classes are FREE**

#### **Classes qualify for SCI training and renewal hours**

FKCE classes satisfy annual renewal hours for Los Angeles County Resource Parents (Foster Parents) that are licensed by the State of California. The rates and required hours are:

#### **SPECIAL CARE INCREMENT TRAINING**

The Special Care Increment (SCI) training was developed by the Foster and Kinship Care Education (FKCE) Programs in Los Angeles County in collaboration with the Los Angeles County Department of Children and Family Services and the Alliance for Children's Rights. The SCI training is designed for resource parents caring for children/youth and non-minor dependents in the Child welfare system. The course cannot be delivered to anyone under the age of 18 or audience that is not approved under the FKCE program. The SCI course may only be delivered to Los Angeles County Resource parents or those resource parents caring for Los Angeles County Children in the child welfare system from Los Angeles County (unless prohibited by CCCC guidelines). To receive a certificate for class hours in full, participants must arrive by the start of class. Students entering 15 minutes after class begins or leaving class before the end will not receive credit for attendance. Pre-registration is not required for renewal hour classes; however, pre-registration is required for pre-service classes.

FKCE is the only entity that can provide the SCI 12-hour training and this curriculum cannot be used by any entity outside of FKCE (i.e., a non-profit organization, Foster Family Agencies, STRTP or another outside agency or non-profit not mentioned other than FKCE)

Participants must complete the 12 hours SCI training at the same college to receive a certificate of completion

Renewal classes meet on Saturday's campus in the **VIRTUAL** unless otherwise specified  
Children are not permitted at workshops.

Beginning July 2021 this course is required in order to care for any foster child under the jurisdiction of the LA County DCFS. This course replaces D rate &amp; F rate training and focuses on fostering children with special needs. After taking this training, Resource Parents may take a 4-hour training on a specialized topic of their choosing to meet the full 16-hours required for SCI certification.</p> <p>This training covers trauma and how it influences a child/youth's behavior, as well as various techniques to manage behaviors using a trauma informed lens. You will also learn about parenting styles and the languages of love. In addition, you will gain a basic understanding of medication management, learn about different types of psychotropic medications and about the rights of foster youth related to medication.</p>	Theresa Reed, ME.d

## GET YOUR COMMERCIAL DRONE LICENSE AND START MAKING MONEY! (IN PERSON)

*Aerial Photography - Roofing Checks - Real Estate Video – Weddings - GoPro Stunts*

Just think of all the money you could make if you flew commercially.... and without spending the big bucks getting a "real" commercial pilot license. The FAA now allows you to apply for your commercial drone/UAS (Unmanned Aerial Vehicles) license, called a Remote Pilot Certificate, by passing a multiple-choice test and paying a small fee. No experience needed.

If you're flying your drone for fun in your back yard, you do not need a license. If you wish to make money taking pictures, then you must have an FAA 14 CFR part 107 Remote Pilot Certificate.

This 8-hour Community Education course will help you prepare to take



the Remote Pilot/FAA Test to receive certification. This course is classroom instruction only. There will not be any drone flying.

You must be at least 16 years old and have a valid government-issued picture ID. The test center fee is \$150 (FAA regulated and is not included in the price of the class. You will need to pass a TSA background check before receiving your license.
